7. Report from the president – Terje Slydahl/Marius H. Johannessen, NOR

- After the annual meeting last year, we made our letter to ICSF. The letter pointed out our thoughts and concerns for the future of casting sport, we presented a four point strategy. We received no reply from ICSF.
- -In March the covid-19 pandemic "closed down" Europe. ICSF decided all international championships in 2020 to be postponed to 2021. SCF had to cancel their World Championship in Flycasting, and Norway canceled the Nordic Championship in casting.
- Only national activities was possible for our federations in 2020.

8. Financial report from Linnea Morild, SWE

Result of the year: SEK -1 738,66. There is SEK 57 025,03 on the bank account. Linnea referenced the report and it is added to the Minutes of the meeting. No member fees were paid in 2020.

9. Election of board members and deputies for 2021

Estonia: Allan Lahi as board member and Dmitri Borovkov as deputy.

Finland: Bror-Eric Granfelt as board member and Tapani Mikola as deputy.

Sweden: Eldar Karat as board member and Linnea Morild as deputy.

Norway: Terje Slydahl as board member, Marius as deputy.

10. Election of president and secretary/treasurer for 2021

Terje Slydahl, NOR, was elected as president and Linnea Morild, SWE, was elected secretary/treasurer for 2021.

11. Election of auditor for 2021

The Swedish Casting Federation's auditor will act for 2021.

12. Membership fee for 2021

The fees for 2021 will be 100 Euros for Sweden and Norway, and 10 Euros for Finland and Estonia. If Denmark and /or Iceland join the Unites Nordic Casting Federation on a permanent basis, their membership fee will also be 10 Euros each. If we invite them as guests to our annual meeting they don't need to pay the membership fee.

It was agreed no one needs to pay the 2020 membership fee, as no invoice was issued last year.

13. Time and place for the Nordic Championships 2021

Nordic Championships in Casting will be held in Norway 21-22.8.2021 at Ås, Breivoll (30 min ride from Oslo). Deadline for confirming the event will be organized is 1st. of June.

As the World Championship in Flycasting this year in Sweden, probably will be postponed; Norway will discuss the possibility to add Flycasting or an interactive Nordic competition. As the World Championship in Flycasting in Nothern-Ireland is scheduled for 2022, the next Nordic Championship in Flycasting will probably not be held until 2023.

14. Time and place for the annual meeting of UNCF 2022

UNCF annual meeting will be held in Tallinn, Estonia in January 29. 2022

15. **Tournaments 2021**

Nordic Championship in casting 21-22.8. in Norway / probably interactive competition. Stockholm Spelen in Sweden — will probably be cancelled this year.

Tallinn Indoor Cup – set to 24.4, but will probably be postponed till the end of June.

Estonian Championship/Flycasting competition – will probably be organized in October.

No tournaments planned in Finland this year.

16. Activity reports from member federations

Each country reported their activities in 2020.

All federations were heavily affected by the covid-19 situation in 2020. Most of the activities was cancelled, although some national activity was organized in Sweden, Estonia and Norway. In Finland all activities was closed down.

17. Proposals/Discussions

17.1 Status World Championship Flycasting 2021 / World Championship Casting 2022

- The World Championship in Flycasting 2021 will probably not be organized this year, due to the covid-19 situation. The Championship will maybe be postponed to 2024, as the 2022 Championship is planned in the Nothern-Ireland.
- The planning of World Championship in Casting 2022 in Tallinn is going well. The arena, Kalevi Keskstaadion, is now under reconstruction, and it will be ready next year. The arena and the hotel that will be used for the athletes is very close to the Tallinn airport.

17.2 Status Casting-pool arena Sweden.

Lise-Lotte gave a presentation of the planned casting-pool in Karlshamn.

The budget in total is estimated to be SEK 22. mill.

17.3 Nordic cooperation /ICSF strategy (membership to IWGA/CIPS)

- The Nordic strategy towards ICSF/development of casting-sport made last year, will be an important tool for the changes we think need to take place in ICSF/the casting-sport. At the ICSF GA in 2019 it was decided to give the board of ICSF the legal power to terminate the membership to IWGA/CIPS, if they found it necessary (for economic reasons). CIPS is the organizations that connect us to the world of fishing-sport, and IWGA (and World Games) is an important step on the way to reach the IOC recognition. We agreed on the importance of ICSF to stay as a member to IWGA (and CIPS) to secure that casting sport is part of the sport society on a global level. Linnea has written a letter to ICSF regarding this issue, and ICSF will have the issue rediscussed at the GA in 2021. The ICSF membership to IWGA is payed for 2021. We agreed to have a new Nordic meeting in March to discuss our further strategy on this issue (Norway will invite to that meeting).

17.4 Webshop castingsport

Lise-Lotte informed that Sweden will open a web-shop for all casting-sport equipments on web. They ask member federations to promote the web-shop on each of our net-sites.



17.3 Nordic cooperation / ICSF strategy (membership of IWGA/CIPS)

Background

The Nordic Casting countries are very concerned about the future of an authorized international organization for Castingsport. As you know we are supported with money from the National sport federations in our country, and that some of the money we have is directly connected to international representation, as taking part in World Championships that have participants from 20 countries or more. Other important questions are that our international organization is recognized by the sports organizations in the world, as IWGA and in the future IOC.

With those important questions in our mind, the Nordic countries discussed how they can contribute to the international work, and help to secure a future of ICSF that make it possible to reach the goal that ICSF has in their strategic documents.

The Nordic countries pointed out four strategic issues to be taken care of in the near future.

- 1. Good governance
 - a. Open minded and transparent
- 2. Part of sports sports organizations on a global level
 - a. IWG/
 - b. IOC
- 3. Organization and membership forms
 - a. Inspiring
 - b. Create desire and motivation
 - c. Growth strategy
- 4. Attractive and modern events
 - a. World Championships
 - b. World Cup
 - c. World Games

From the report on ICSF General Assembly 2019

Despite all hard work, we have not succeeded in being on the program of World Games 2021. We have not managed to arrange the IOC recognition. This activity connected to the filing of an application involved hundreds of hours of work and thinking.

- The General Assembly of ICSF grants all legal power for the interruption or termination of the membership at the IWGA, but based on the consequent negotiation with this sports organization **Voting: (adoption) 11 votes in favour and 1 vote against**

- General assembly of ICSF grants all legal power for interruption or termination of the membership at the CIPS, but after the negotiation with this sports organization.

Voting: (adoption) 7 votes in favour, 4 votes against, 1 vote abstained







We are sending you an invoice for membership fees for this year attached. In 2020 we paid and in 2021 we will pay ICSF membership fees to the sports federations where we are members of (GAISF, IWGA, AIMS and CIPS). This will maintain the continuity of our participation in world sports.

As we beleive it's important for ICSF to be part of sports organizations on a global level; How can we ensure that we keep the membership towards IWGA?
